With over 14 miles for walking and biking, the Cricket Frog Trail is built on an old section of railroad right-of-way and takes you through historic Covington, Starsville and Mansfield, and you will enjoy the scenic woodlands in between. Covington Central Park basts a championship level disc

golf course. The 214-acre park is Covington's center piece for recreation.
